Day #1: Participants decided to delay departure for one day due to predictions of bad weather.

Day #2: In anticipation of noon time clearing , 4 boats departed for Solomon's Island on the Patuxent River. Wind was East initially at 12 ks which increased by the trip's end at to closer to 14-18 kts.
